

Please make at least one public hearing accessible by public transit. Richard Montgomery High School is close to Rockville Metro.

Please post the Draft EIS, including the technical reports, on the SHA's World-Wide Web site. The complete, unexpurgated version costs over a thousand dollars if purchased from the State Highway Administration!

I would like to know of your intended actions in these matters.
